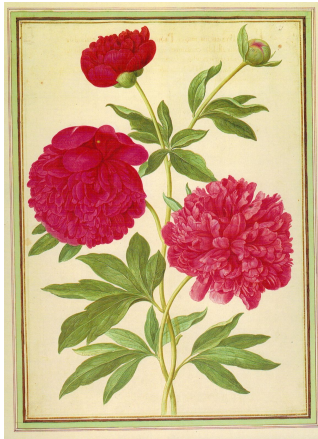




‘So Many Sweet Flowers’ - From Clontarf to Killiney - Watson’s Nurseries 1884-1967
