

Dublin Historical Record (DHR)

Each member receives a copy of every issue of the Society's journal, the *Dublin Historical Record* (otherwise known as the *DHR*). This contains papers on a wide range of topics which have been delivered at Society meetings by members or invited guest speakers.

All papers have been thoroughly researched, referenced and cited. They include new material as well as fresh interpretations of familiar information and comprise a unique source of historical knowledge about Dublin.

Since 1938, when the journal was first published, members have made their research work available to everyone via the *Dublin Historical Record*. Back-issues are available for consultation in many public libraries and can be consulted online at jstor.org/journal/dubhistrec

The material contained in every issue has been indexed by the Society. An initial Index covered the period 1938-2003 and a second Index has now been published to cover the years 2004-2019.
